

Progress in Fullerene Research

Thirteen years of fullerene research since macroscopic amounts of fullerenes became available, have resulted in the publication of approximately fifteen thousand papers, with functionalisation becoming increasingly dominant, and research being ever more directed towards making derivatives with practical uses. Emphasis will be placed in particular on the back-up tools that have been used for structural assignment.
