



*Co-operation Agreement
between
the Electrochemical Society
and
the International Society of Electrochemistry*

Preamble

In view of the common interest in the promotion of electrochemical research and technology and of the extensive overlap between the membership of both societies, the Electrochemical Society (ECS) and the International Society of Electrochemistry (ISE) enter into this agreement to intensify their contacts and their co-operation in the future. The present co-operation agreement refers especially to exchange of information, to the co-ordinated scheduling of scientific meetings, and to the creation of a joint task force, open to other major electrochemical societies, aimed at identifying actions by which both societies may serve the electrochemical community.

1. Exchange of information

Both societies will inform each other of present and future activities. In particular, ECS and ISE will coordinate scheduling of their meetings to avoid overlap.

2. Announcement of meetings

The ISE shall announce ECS meetings on its website and provide links to the ECS pages corresponding to the ECS meetings. The ECS shall announce ISE meetings on its website and provide links to the ISE pages corresponding to the ISE meetings. The ISE will provide a table at its Spring and Annual Meetings with information/applications for ECS, including flyers of upcoming ECS meetings and promotional material of the Journal of the Electrochemical Society. The ECS will provide a table at its Spring and Annual Meetings with information/applications for ISE, including flyers of upcoming ISE meetings and promotional material of *Electrochimica Acta*. These tables are not to be used by either Society as a display for any commercial entities.

3. Sponsorship of meetings

Meeting organizers for ECS or ISE will be allowed to request additional co-sponsorship from ISE or ECS Divisions or Sections, but the present agreement will supersede co-sponsorship at an institutional level.

4. Co-operation on Internet

On the internet, links between the websites of the societies will be installed.

5. Term of the Agreement

This agreement shall enter into force upon execution by both parties and shall remain valid for an initial period of two (2) years. Thereafter it shall be automatically extended for a period of one year unless terminated by either party at the end of the initial period, or at the end of any extension period, by giving at least 3 months prior written notice to the other party.
