



ECS 2015 Subscription Information

ECS (The Electrochemical Society) is a nonprofit society publisher, with publications spanning the entire subject area of electrochemistry and solid state science. ECS publications contain high impact research that becomes more and more relevant every day—a recent evaluation of ECS technical activities suggests that close to 65% of our published work involves the sustainability of our planet. The *Journal of The Electrochemical Society* has been in publication since 1902. In 2012 ECS launched three new journals in order to meet the growing requirement that high-quality publications should meet the needs of researchers and authors by providing more specialized publications. ECS uses a rapid publication model, where articles are published online as soon as they are ready, which means ECS's content collection is growing in richness and quantity every day—approximately 8,000 new articles each year—offering scientists a first look into leading-edge research.



Journal of The Electrochemical Society (JES)

JES has been in existence since 1902 and is one of the most frequently cited publications among all electrochemistry journals listed in the Journal Citation Index. JES publishes an average of 85 peer-reviewed articles each month (about 550 pages). JES publishes peer-reviewed original research covering batteries, fuel cells, corrosion, electrodeposition, sensors, bioelectrochemistry, electrochemical engineering, electroanalytical chemistry, and more, as they relate to the further understanding of processes of both fundamental and technological importance leading to the rational design and optimization of small and large scale devices.



ECS Journal of Solid State Science and Technology (JSS)

JSS is one of the newest peer-reviewed journals from ECS launched in 2012. JSS covers fundamental and applied areas of solid state science and technology including experimental and theoretical aspects of the chemistry and physics of materials and devices. Of particular focus are the areas of solid state materials and device processing as they relate to the establishment of electrical, optical, physical and chemical properties, the relationship of material properties to device properties, the process science and technology of materials and devices, and the characterization of bulk materials, thin films, interfaces, surfaces, and devices.



ECS Electrochemistry Letters (EEL)

EEL was started in 2012 when *Electrochemistry and Solid State Letters* (ESL) was replaced by two letters journals, EEL and SSL. EEL is dedicated to the rapid dissemination of peer-reviewed and concise research reports in the same areas as covered by the *Journal of The Electrochemical Society* (JES).



ECS Solid State Letters (SSL)

SSL launched in 2012 and publishes peer-reviewed and concise research reports in the same areas as covered by the *ECS Journal of Solid State Science and Technology* (JSS).

Abstracting and Indexing

All ECS journals are abstracted and/or indexed in: Chemical Abstracts (CAS), CrossRef, EBSCO Discovery, Ex Libris Primo, Google, Google Scholar, INSPEC, ISI Web of Science, Medline/PubMed, MSN, ProQuest, Science Citation Index, and others.



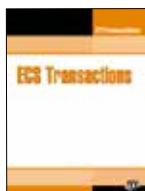
Electrochemical and Solid-State Letters (ESL) (ARCHIVE)

ECS Transactions (ECST)

ECST is an online database of technical papers—a high-quality venue for authors and an excellent resource for researchers. ECST includes full-text content of proceedings from ECS meetings and ECS sponsored conferences. The papers appearing in ECST are reviewed to ensure that submissions meet generally-accepted scientific standards.



The Electrochemical Society Interface (Open Access)

Interface is a quarterly news magazine that provides a forum for the lively exchange of ideas and news within the scientific community. Published in paper and online (with free access to all), issues highlight special features on the state of electrochemical and solid state science and technology. Content-rich and in full color, *Interface* engages readers with a featured scientific research section, summaries of breakthroughs, and industry news.

ECS Meeting Abstracts (Open Access)

ECS Meeting Abstracts are published online twice a year (with free access to all). This publication contains extended abstracts of technical papers presented at the spring and fall meetings of ECS. ECS also publishes meeting abstract volumes for other meetings.

Monographs

ECS monographs provide authoritative, detailed accounts of specific topics in electrochemistry and solid state science and technology. These titles are sponsored by ECS and published in cooperation with noted publishers such as John A. Wiley & Sons.

Academic institutions: the full-time equivalent is calculated as all full-time enrollment, added to all full-time employees plus one-third part-time employees, across the institution.

For the 2015 subscription term, subscribers to JES will also receive JSS at no additional fee; subscribers to JSS will also receive JES at no additional fee. Also, subscribers to EEL will also receive SSL at no additional fee; subscribers to SSL will also receive EEL at no additional fee. ECS packages will include the content of all four technical journals, although rates are based on only two journals.
- Tiers are based on the number of FTEs for the entire organization, not an individual department or division. If you need help with your tier, please contact ECS.
- Subscribers to the print edition of the *Journal of The Electrochemical Society* also receive the print edition of *Interface* at no additional cost.
- Package prices are discounted off full list prices.
- Missing Issues—Claims for missing issues must be received within 90 days of issue date for U.S. subs and within 120 days for non-U.S. subs. Claims for older issues will not be fulfilled. Issues can be claimed only once due to no arrival or damaged arrival, and single copies only will be sent as replacement issues. Qualified claims for print journals delivered to a freight forwarding company or consolidation warehouse will only be honored for the delivery to the primary destination. Costs for claims to the final subscriber destination are the responsibility of the agent or institution placing the order.
